

Living Streets Hamilton: Hillcrest World of Walkable Art Stroll, November 2014





Hillcrest Walk

Park near the Hillcrest Library in Masters Ave.

Start at Hillcrest Park behind the library and walk through the bush, taking the right hand fork past the scout den. Although not Jeremy's work, there is a great pattern on the end wall of the building. Cross the park to turn left onto Mansel Ave and then right on to the walkway and through the pedestrian tunnel (under Cambridge Rd), which contains Jeremy's art work.

Proceed past Burger King and down the ramp to the other tunnel containing Jeremy's work, to emerge on Morrinsville Rd. Carry on to the bus shelter with Jeremy's art work then head down to the pedestrian crossing and back to St Francis church to walk through to Mansel Ave.

Then follow Mansel Ave to Morris Rd, through Jansen Park and the Hillcrest High School grounds, emerging on Carrington Ave.

Cross to Vesty Ave, turn right onto Aurora Tce and go to the end, where there is a walkway through to the bottom of the Management School.

Head up the steps to Hillcrest Rd and cross using the pedestrian crossing.

Turn left and head down Hillcrest Rd to St Johns College.

Cross the road at the bus shelter with Jeremy's art work. Continue along to the walkway to Dorothy Place and turn right on to Aurora Tce.

From Aurora Tce, turn left at Masters Ave and continue until you are opposite the bus shelter with Jeremy's art work. Cross the road and return to your starting point.
