



Living Streets Hamilton

WATERWAY WALK, November 13th, 2011

- [Start in Pickering Crescent, and proceed down the path through the gully behind the school to emerge in Te Puroa Place.
- [Head back to the left and cross Wairere Drive (with caution) to cross Hukanui Rd at the underpass at the roundabout, and Wairere Drive again at the underpass.
- [Follow the walkway behind the houses on Brooklyn Court, down to the path in the reserve below Brooklyn Court. Head slightly right and cross the bridge over the stream.
- [Follow the main path up through Tauhara Park, leading to the children's playground area. For those who would like a break, there is a small kiosk selling drinks and ice creams, and a public toilet available at this point.
- [Follow the perimeter of the park back to where you entered, cross the bridge again and head left following the stream below Brooklyn Court.
- [Cross Hukanui Rd (CARE) at the entrance to Mangaiti reserve. Head left, and then left again at the next path junction, to follow the gully path along to where it emerges into Keswick Crescent.
- [Turn right into Keswick and follow the path until you reach Helmsdale Court on your right. Go to the end of this cul-de-sac and head left through the local walkway between the houses to rejoin the gully path. At the first T-junction, head left.
- [At the next T-junction, also head left. Follow the path, which takes you back to the underpass at the Wairere Drive roundabout on Hukanui Rd. Use the underpass to get back over to Hukanui Rd, and follow the footpath back to Pickering Cres.
