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General comments and what can be done to make it better for pedestrians	
<p>1. Road work layout and space allocation Is it wide enough to cope with pedestrian flows? For wheelchairs and double buggies? Turning space?</p>	
<p>2. Footpath condition Is the footpath surface in good condition? Are the ramps smooth and at an acceptable gradient? Are tactile pavers present? Are they correctly installed? Is there flooding potential? Is there contrast when surface changes levels?</p>	
<p>3. Obstructions Do the barriers/fencing/street furniture allow free passage? Are there obstructions that hinder a sight-impaired road user? Are there temporary obstructions on the footway? Is there an alternative route?</p>	
<p>4. Crossing points and desire lines Are all street crossings at street level? Are desire lines blocked?</p>	
<p>5. Traffic Does the vehicular traffic intimidate or endanger? Are cyclists using the footpath? Is the on street parking appropriate? Does it obstruct visibility?</p>	
<p>6. Signage Are signs appropriate for the pedestrian environment? Are the signs clear and easy to read?</p>	
<p>7. Personal security: Does the site feel safe?</p>
