

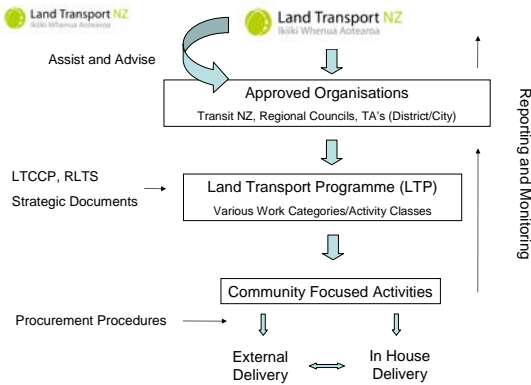
## Community Focused Land Transport Activities Funding Process

## Background

- From 1 July 2007, Land Transport NZ will fund approved organisations for community focused activities to meet local priorities
- Land Transport NZ will no longer direct fund activities via the Community Road Safety Programme
- Councils will apply for this funding in their annual application to Land Transport NZ

## Community Focused Activities

### Three work categories

- Community Coordination
- Community Programmes
- Community Advertising

## Local share component

- Land Transport NZ funds CFA at a 75% Financial Assistance Rate (FAR)
- Councils can choose to...
  - Fund an activity at 100%
  - Pass on the 25% local share
  - Form a partnership (e.g. in kind donations)

## How can others get involved?

- Some councils have a contestable "project fund" – talk to local RSC about application dates
- AO's are interested in partnerships with agencies/groups – talk to your local RSC about what projects are coming up

- AO's submit a draft programme to Land Transport NZ in November each year. If you have a project or idea talk to the AO before this date.
- Keep in mind that Council activities are driven by LTCCPs.
