Abstract Remit

Workplace travel planning is becoming a popular way for businesses to address increasing traffic congestion and travel times. GreenFleet helps businesses initiate workplace travel plans that encourage businesses to look outside the car for viable alternatives for them. There is a growing sample of case studys where businesses have introduced incentives for staff to walk and attemmpted to overcome some of the barriers to walking. This presentation aims to highlight this increasing popularity for business walking, and to outline the ways GreenFleet members have encouraged staff to walk more.
